**When:** Thursday, August 19, 2010 10:00am - 5:30pm

**Where:** Stephen Avenue (8 Avenue between 3 Street SW and 1 Street SE) Calgary, AB

**Sponsored by:** downtown calgary

**SET UP**

- Artists (or helpers) will need to bring art / display items to Stephen Avenue on the morning of the event.
- We encourage all artists to be completely set up by 10:00am.
- Artists (or helpers) will be able to drive a vehicle on Stephen Avenue to unload materials.
- If using Calgary Transit's C-Train, the trains stop 1 block over on 7<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Be prepared for the elements (wind) by securing all your art down.
- Artists are allowed to bring art, easels, tables, chairs, display cases, art supplies, business cards and promotional materials, umbrellas or pop up tents (no walls). Please be sure all your items fit into your 10 x 10 foot space.

**DURING THE DAY**

- We strongly encourage all artists to be creating on site.
- Artists are able to sell their works and will need to be prepared according to the form of payments they receive.
- canadian artists for the poor will not be accepting payment for any of the art on display or for sale.

**TAKE DOWN**

- Artists (or helpers) can begin packing up at 5:30pm. Artists will need to have all displays and art off of the street by 6:00pm as Stephen Avenue allows vehicle traffic again at 6:00pm.
- You will be permitted to drive your vehicle on Stephen Avenue to load up your items.

**COST**

- The cost for the 10 x 10 space for the day is \$100. If you wish to send a cheque, please make it out to canadian artists for the poor. You can also pay through our website.

**GUIDELINES FOR ART ON DISPLAY**

- Any art on display or for sale will need to be 'family-friendly'. Pornographic, racist or disturbing images will not be permitted.

**RESPONSIBILITY**

- Anything you bring to the event (including personal belongings) is your responsibility.
- If bringing your children with you for the day, we respectfully ask you to keep them under control.
- If your items are stolen, lost, destroyed or damaged during transportation to or from the event or at the event, canadian artists for the poor is NOT responsible. You may already have insurance that would cover you or you may want to purchase insurance for such purposes.
